Entries: 30 (Europe has 12 places available in Czechia, exclusive CZE as organiser)

Qualified: CZE (organiser), RUS (1st of the 2004 W19 ECh), NOR (2nd of the 2004 W19 ECh)

Draw: 6 groups of 4 teams, 1 group of 3 teams - **10 teams will qualify for the final**

tournament in CZE

Groups 1-3: 2 teams will qualify out of 4; groups 4-7: 1 team will qualify out

of 4 (groups 4-6) resp. out of 3 (group 7)

Procedure of 2005 Women's U20 and Men's U21 WCh - Draw 6 Nov 2004

2005 Women's U20 World Championship Qualification Europe

Entries: 30 (Europe has 12 places available plus organiser CZE)

Qualified: CZE (organiser), **RUS** (1st of the 2004 W19 ECh), **NOR** (2nd of the 2004 W19 ECh) **Participants:** AUT, BIH, BUL, CRO, DEN, ESP, FRA, GER, GRE, HUN, ISL, ISR, ITA, LTU,

MDA, MKD, NED, POL, POR, ROM, SCG, SLO, SUI, SVK, SWE, TUR, UKR

Groups: 6 groups of 4 teams, 1 group of 3 teams

Seeding according to the following pots:

Pot 1: SCG, FRA, CRO, DEN, GER, POL, ESP (to be "placed" into row 1, groups 1 to 7)

Pot 2: ROM, SLO, SWE, POR, ISL, AUT (to be drawn to row 2, groups 1 to 7)

Pot 3: BIH, BUL, GRE, HUN, ISR, ITA, LTU, MDA, MKD, NED, SUI, SVK, TUR, UKR

(based on the ranking of the 2004 Women's 19 ECh in CZE)

Procedure of the draw:

1.1. teams of pot 1 are placed into row 1, groups 1-7

1.2. teams of pot 2 are drawn to row 2, groups 1-7

1.3. remaining 14 teams are drawn one by one to the open positions

2. draw of the teams having the right to organise the qualification tournament

1 – 14 August 2005

LTU, LUX, MDA, MKD, NED, NOR, POL, POR, ROM, RUS, SCG, SLO, SUI, SVK,

SWE, TUR, UKR

Groups: 7 groups of 4 teams, 1 group of 3 teams

Seeding according to the following pots:

Pot 1: SLO, SWE, ROM, AUT, POR, ESP, FRA, SUI (to be drawn to row 1, groups 1 to 8)

Pot 2: CZE, ISL, POL, MKD (to be drawn to row 2, groups 1 to 8)

Pot 3: BEL, BUL, CRO, CYP, EST, GEO, GRE, ISR, ITA, LTU, LUX, MDA, NED, NOR, RUS, SCG,

SVK, TUR, UKR

(based on the ranking of the 2004 Men's 20 ECh in LAT)

Procedure of the draw:

- 1.1. teams of pot 1 are drawn to row 1, groups 1-8
- 1.2. teams of pot 2 are drawn to row 2, groups 1-8
- 1.3. remaining 19 teams are drawn one by one to the open positions
- 2. draw of the teams having the right to organise the qualification tournament

15 – 28 August 2005
